

Dear Crafters:

Klondike Days will be celebrating its **20th** year! We are very excited to provide you the opportunity of being a part of a large number of crafters.

Please join us on February 20th and 21st, 2010 in Eagle River, Wisconsin for Northern Wisconsin's premier winter craft event.

Only Original work done by exhibitor may be displayed!

Those wishing to participate must submit 3 photos of the work that will be exhibited. **Absolutely no wholesale, imported, or machine (either screen-printed or reproduced) will be allowed. Violators will be asked to leave with no refunds. This will be strictly enforced this year!** Crafters will again be located in the new High School Field House. Booth size will be 10' x 10' with a fee of \$100.00 per space. If you need power the cost will be increased by \$15.00 per space. Spaces will be handled on a first come first served basis only. Send in your applications soon – as prime spaces will go fast.

Hours for the craft show will be 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Saturday and 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Sunday. We will allow for crafters to set up Friday night, February 19th from 4 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Set up for Saturday morning will be from 6:30 a.m. until 8:45 a.m.

- 1.) Alcohol and tobacco products are not allowed on school grounds. Violators will be asked to leave and reservation fees will not be refunded.
- 2.) In efforts to boost the scholarship program that we already have in place we would like all crafters to please donate **one** item that we will raffle off.
- 3.) **There will be no eating or drinking in the field house. Water is allowed and that will be it.** We will have monitors at the doors stationed at all times to prevent crafters and visitors alike from taking food/drinks into the field house. **This is not negotiable!**
- 4.) The school also asked that crafters **not use stickers** on their goods, instead use tags that tie on. Some of the stickers were very difficult to get peeled up after being walked on both days. We would ask that you respect this request.
- 5.) If the above policy statements are a problem, then you will need to make the choice not to attend or to bring a helper to comply. While this sounds strong we need to respect the rules of the school and help us make this a continued successful event.

Details of parking, set up locations, etc. will be provided with confirmation of your booth space. If you notice a red check mark on your letter that means we are familiar with your crafts and no pictures will be required, only a self-addressed stamped envelope for notification would be necessary. Please return all paperwork and photos no later than **January 29th, 2010**. Letters of confirmation along with participant passes will be mailed out the end of January. If you will be in need of accommodations, room reservation information can be provided by the Eagle River Chamber of Commerce at 1-800-359-6315. Call the Chamber for lodging inquiries only. We also have hotels that specifically have rooms reserved under "KLONDIKE PARTICIPANT".
